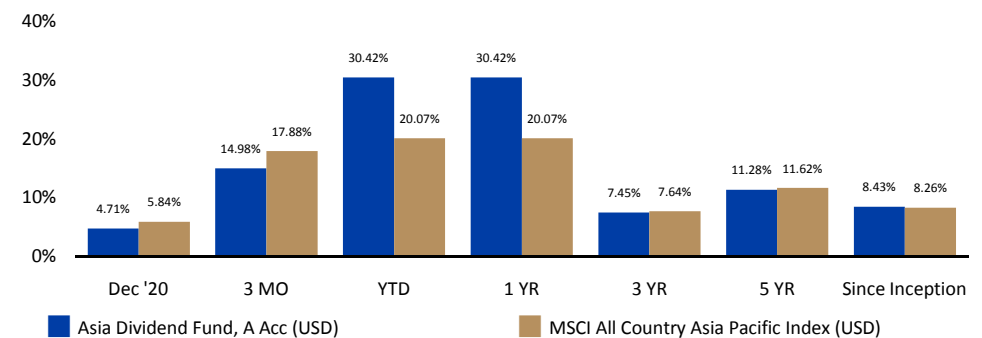

It is authorised by the Commission de Surveillance du Secteur Financier (CSSF) as a UCITS and is only registered for public offer and sale in Finland, France, Germany, Luxembourg, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland and the United Kingdom.
